Lack of experience in using equipment	Med	Instruction document issued by Outdoor Education Unit given to each group. Group nominates one member of staff to be “Activity Leader”. Member of visiting staff to be present at all times	Low
Maintenance of equipment	Med	Regular statutory checks by supplier. Monthly checks by Centre staff (records kept by Centre Manager)	Low
Trapping Fingers	Med	Briefing given to each group by activity leader. Advice to include warning about handling planks and holding onto equipment	Low
Rope burns and grazes	Med	Briefing given each group by activity leader. Advice to include warning about sliding down ropes and advice on how to hold on. Arms and legs should be covered	Low
Lifting Injuries	Med	Briefing given to each group by activity leader. Briefing to include advice on lifting equipment and other people	Low
Slipping off beams/ wires	Med	Briefing given to each group by activity leader. ‘Spotters’ to be identified and briefed for each activity. Guidance on ‘Spotting’ should be read by all staff supervising the activity.
